Who are we and what do we do

We are a County wide Outreach Team working within the Rehabilitation Medicine Service in Lincolnshire. We provide a specialist interdisciplinary assessment for adults with a long term Neurological condition or following major trauma who have complex rehabilitation needs.

Role

Our role is to provide assessment, advice, support and information to promote self management and independence, to enable you to maintain a quality of life and adjust to your changing needs.

Team Members

Clinical Nurse Specialists offer advice, information and support to you and your family on all aspects of healthcare needs related to your condition.

Specialist Occupational Therapists provide specialist assessment, treatment planning and reviewing progress towards goals taking account of your occupations, role, environment and lifestyle.

Neuro Physiotherapists will plan individual home management programmes and provide specialist advice and support.
