Community neurorehabilitation outreach team

We are a county-wide multi-disciplinary outreach team working within the Rehabilitation Medicine Service in Lincolnshire.

The service is made up of 4 teams based in Lincoln, Grantham, Louth and Boston. We provide a specialist inter-disciplinary assessment for adults with a long term neurological condition or following major trauma who have complex rehabilitation needs. This excludes those with Parkinson's disease or a stroke whose care is managed by a different team.

Our role is to provide assessment, advice, support and information to promote self-management and independence, to enable adults to maintain a quality of life and adjust to their changing needs.

Meet the team

Clinical Nurse Specialist:

Provides a clinical nurse specialist service to adults with long term neurological conditions or following multiple trauma with complex rehabilitation needs in the community. Working in collaboration with other colleagues and members of the multi-disciplinary team to provide the highest possible standards of care and support for patients and their families.

Specialist Neuro-Physiotherapist:

Plans individual home management programmes, advice and support. Physiotherapists have skills in promoting physical activity, re-ablement and empowering individuals through selfmanagement.

Specialist Occupational Therapist:

Promotes health and wellbeing through occupations to enable clients to participate in everyday activities. Interventions aim to promote optimal occupational performance and function, whilst maximise clients independence.

Specialist Dietitian:

Assess individuals nutritional intakes and offer advice and support to help people meet their nutrition and hydration needs in order to improve health, rehabilitation potential and overall wellbeing.

Support Staff:

Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy assistants help individuals to complete programmes agreed with the therapist, to aid rehabilitation and promote independence.
