We work closely with all members of the Lung Multi-Disciplinary Team at Lincoln County Hospital as well as GPs, Community Nursing Teams and other Allied Healthcare Professionals that may be involved in your care.

How can we help?

We are here to offer specialist advice, support and information to:

- people undergoing investigations where there is a concern they **may** have lung cancer.
- people with a primary lung cancer diagnosis.
- families and important others of those undergoing investigations or with a lung cancer diagnosis.

Keyworker role

We will be your 'keyworkers.' The role of the keyworker is to act as a point of contact, help co-ordinate your care and provide information on investigations and treatment options to support you and your family/important others with decision making.

We can also refer to other specialist teams to ensure you feel supported throughout your care, including both healthcare and volunteer agencies, to support you at home where necessary.

Follow-up appointments

We are a **very** busy team and a Macmillan Lung Cancer Clinical Nurse Specialist cannot always attend clinic for your appointment.

If you wish to see one of us in clinic, please leave us a message a few days before your appointment and we shall make every attempt to be there. If for any reason we cannot attend we will contact you by telephone.

Alternatively, you can ask a member of the clinic staff to bleep us once you arrive at the clinic. Again, if we are unable to attend we shall contact you by telephone as soon as we can.
