Respiratory (Chest) Physician: Doctor who specialises in chest medicine, who will meet you to find out what is wrong and then plan and manage your care with the other specialists.

Lung Nurse Specialist: Provides advice, support and information for you and your family throughout your care. Provides advice on management of symptoms at any point from your diagnosis.

Radiologist: Doctor who specialises in performing and reading x-rays and scans.

Special staff and meetings

Macmillan Lung Nurse specialist

The Macmillan Lung nurse Specialist will be your 'Keyworker'. The role of the Keyworker is to provide you with a point of contact and to help co-ordinate your care. Your Keyworker can offer you support and advice about your care and treatment, even if you are attending a different hospital for your treatment. Your Keyworker will also be able to put you in touch if necessary with other professionals who can offer support and care.

Multi-disciplinary team (MDT) meeting

The MDT meeting is attended by healthcare professionals who specialise in treating and caring for people with lung problems. They will discuss your case and make recommendations about the most appropriate treatment or care for you. This may involve further tests or investigations, or referral to another specialist.

Once you have had your tests and investigations your case will be discussed at the weekly lung MDT meeting.

You will be informed of the outcome of the meeting as soon as possible.
