This gives everyone the opportunity to attend and takes into consideration the vast area that Lincolnshire covers.

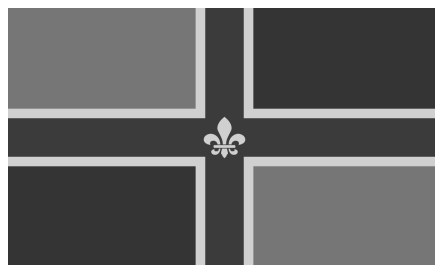
