Your specialist doctors and your Macmillan Lung Nurse Specialist work closely together, which means if you need any help they can liaise with your GP or other people involved in your care, for example District Nurses and Community Macmillan nurses as appropriate.

Why are we offering you this service?

- To reduce any anxieties/issues/problems that you may have following an out-patient appointment.
- Provide additional choice of support to you and your family.
- Holistic follow-up is an important component of posttreatment cancer care, it is physical, social and psychological rehabilitation.
