Aim of the leaflet

This leaflet will give you guidance on how we will keep you updated with information and findings during our review of your care or that of your baby or child.

If you, your baby or child, are involved in an incident and following the initial discussion with the Matron and/or Consultant, the Women and Children's Risk Team will contact you on a monthly basis. This will be via telephone or by letter if preferred, to keep you up-to-date with the progress of our review.

On completion of the review you will be invited to attend a Duty of Candour Meeting. The Women and Children's Multidisciplinary Team will discuss with you what has occurred in a compassionate, open and honest way to help you and your family understand what occurred and why. By doing this we are maintaining an open and honest culture within our services for our families.

If you need to contact the Risk Team there is a central telephone number and if out of hours, an answerphone. Leave your name, contact telephone number and a short message and a member of the Risk Team will call you back at the earliest opportunity.
